## Math Tutoring

Math tutors are available in the Jane Johnsen Center for OUL students needing assistance with their math course. An appointment is not necessary. Tutoring is free to all students registered for a course at OUL. Students can walk in for help during the hours listed on this schedule for your math course. The Jane Johnsen Center is in Room 105 Brasee Hall across from the Bobcat Bistro.

## Math Tutoring Policies

- Sign in on the log sheet each time you come in for help. The student receptionist will direct you to an available tutor who can help you with your class. Not all tutors can tutor every math class. You may request a specific tutor that you have worked with before.
- Bring all necessary materials such as textbooks and notes with you so that the tutors can see what you are working on in class.
- Bring in questions about problems you have attempted or worked in class, or a specific topic that you do not understand. Remember

math is learned by doing and by practicing work outside the classroom if you want to do well on your tests.

- Tutors cannot work any problems for you that will be graded as this is considered academic misconduct in the OU Student Code of Conduct.
- If there are other students waiting, tutoring sessions may have to be limited to 30 minutes.
- Students can receive two hours of tutoring per week per course. This is to ensure that tutors are available to all students and that students are working independently outside of tutoring on their course work.
- Please remember that our tutors are students too. If there are questions that they cannot answer, you may need to ask your professor during their office hours.
- If we need to change the math tutoring schedule, an up-to-date schedule is available from the receptionist or on our web site.

### Online Tutoring –Available 24/7

If our scheduled hours do not work for you, go to: [tutor.com/oulp](https://tutor.com/oulp). Once there, students new to tutor.com can create an account following the instructions on the page. You must use your OU email address. Tutor.com is free and can be used for: Math (up to Calculus I) as well as many other courses at OUL.

## Math Tutoring for the Fall Semester 2019 – All tutoring is free to OUL students!

Math tutoring is available in the Jane Johnsen Center in Room 105 Brasee Hall across from the Bobcat Bistro on a walk-in basis. Please sign in with the receptionist. When other students are waiting for help, tutoring sessions may have a time limit of thirty minutes. There is a limit of two hours of math tutoring per week per course to ensure that tutors are available to help all students and that students are working independently outside of tutoring on their course work.
